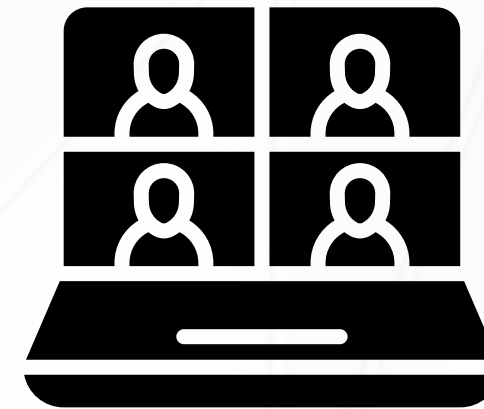

# NURSING BOOKS PROJECT \$5,900

**COMPLETED**

The Nursing Books Project was launched to support Cuttington University in Liberia. The purpose was to provide essential nursing textbooks and resources to help the university meet the accreditation requirements set by the Government of Liberia. The project was successfully completed, playing a crucial role in the university's ability to secure accreditation. This achievement enhances the quality of nursing education and will contribute to the development of a skilled healthcare workforce in Liberia. Funding for the project included a \$3,000 donation from the Episcopal Diocese of Texas, USA; with the remaining contributions provided by our alumni. Most of the support from alumni came from former nursing students.



# BUDGET RELIEF AWARD

## \$50,000

The Cuttington University Alumni Association in the Americas (CUAAA) initiated a \$50,000 Budget Relief Award to help Cuttington University address critical financial challenges. This award, designed to cover essential budgetary expenses, was disbursed in three installments starting in 2022: \$20,000, followed by \$15,000, with the final payment made in 2024. By fulfilling this commitment, CUAAA reaffirms its unwavering dedication to supporting the financial stability and growth of its alma mater.

# VSAT AWARD \$36,000

## \$24,000 BAL \$12,000

CUAAA also awarded Cuttington University \$36,000 to cover the maintenance costs of the Vsat equipment donated by Alumnus Theo Dennis. The maintenance cost is \$12,000 per year, and CUAAA has consistently fulfilled these payments, ensuring ongoing support for the university's connectivity and communication needs. The final year is being implemented.

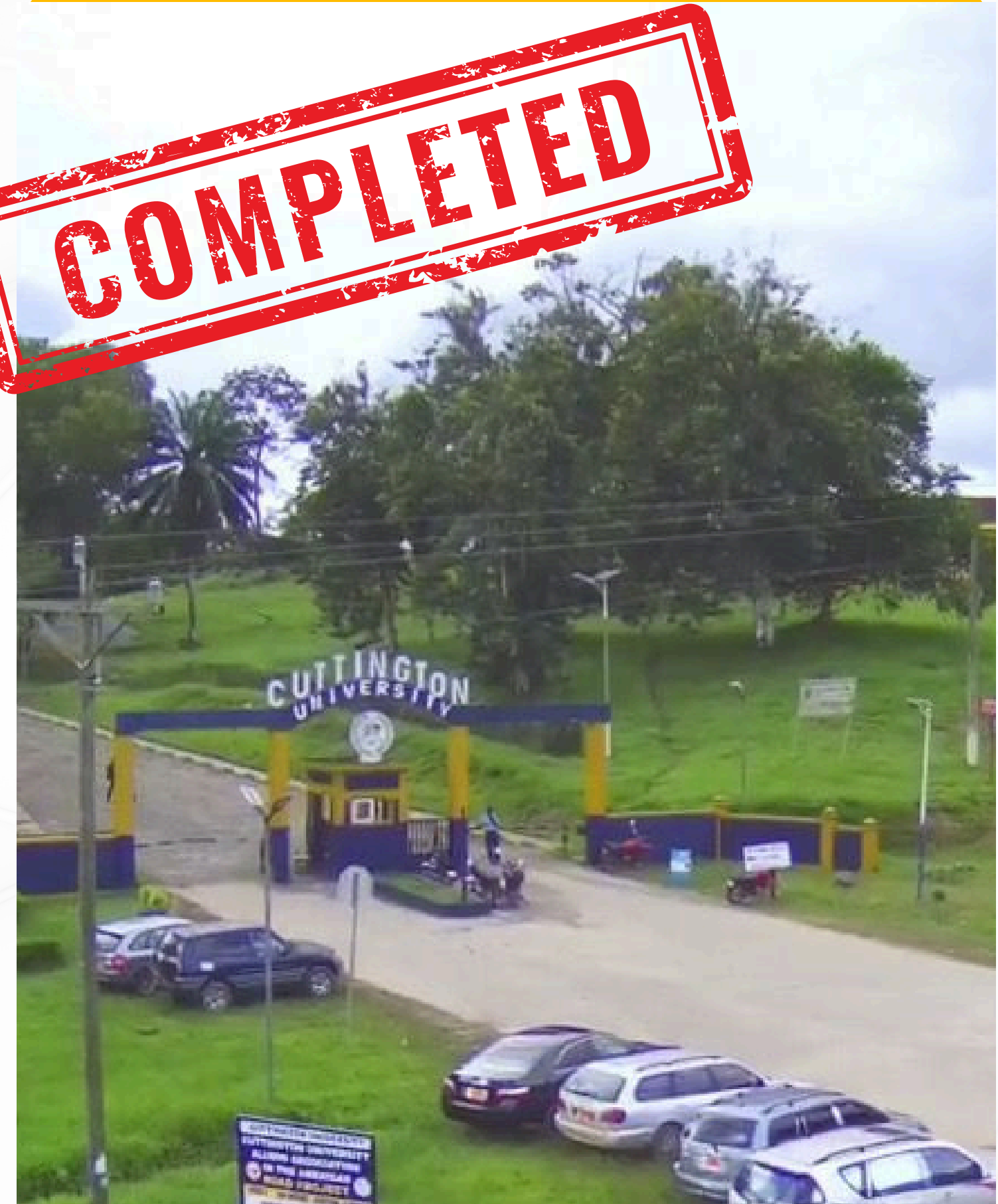
# CUAAA ROAD PAVING PROJECT

## \$88,000

The Cuttington University Alumni Association in the Americas (CUAAA) has successfully completed an \$88,000 road rehabilitation project on Cuttington University's main campus in Suakoko, Bong County. This transformative initiative upgraded the campus entrance, replacing the dusty, uneven road with a smooth and accessible pathway, significantly improving access for students, faculty, and the community.

The dedication ceremony, held in October 2024, was graced by distinguished alumni of Cuttington University. His Excellency Jeremiah Koung, Vice President of the Republic of Liberia, officially cut the ribbon, while Hon. Cllr. Oswald Natu Tweh, Minister of Justice, attended in support of this milestone achievement.

This project reflects CUAAA's unwavering commitment to enhancing the university's infrastructure and fostering a welcoming and functional campus environment for future generations.

## VISION

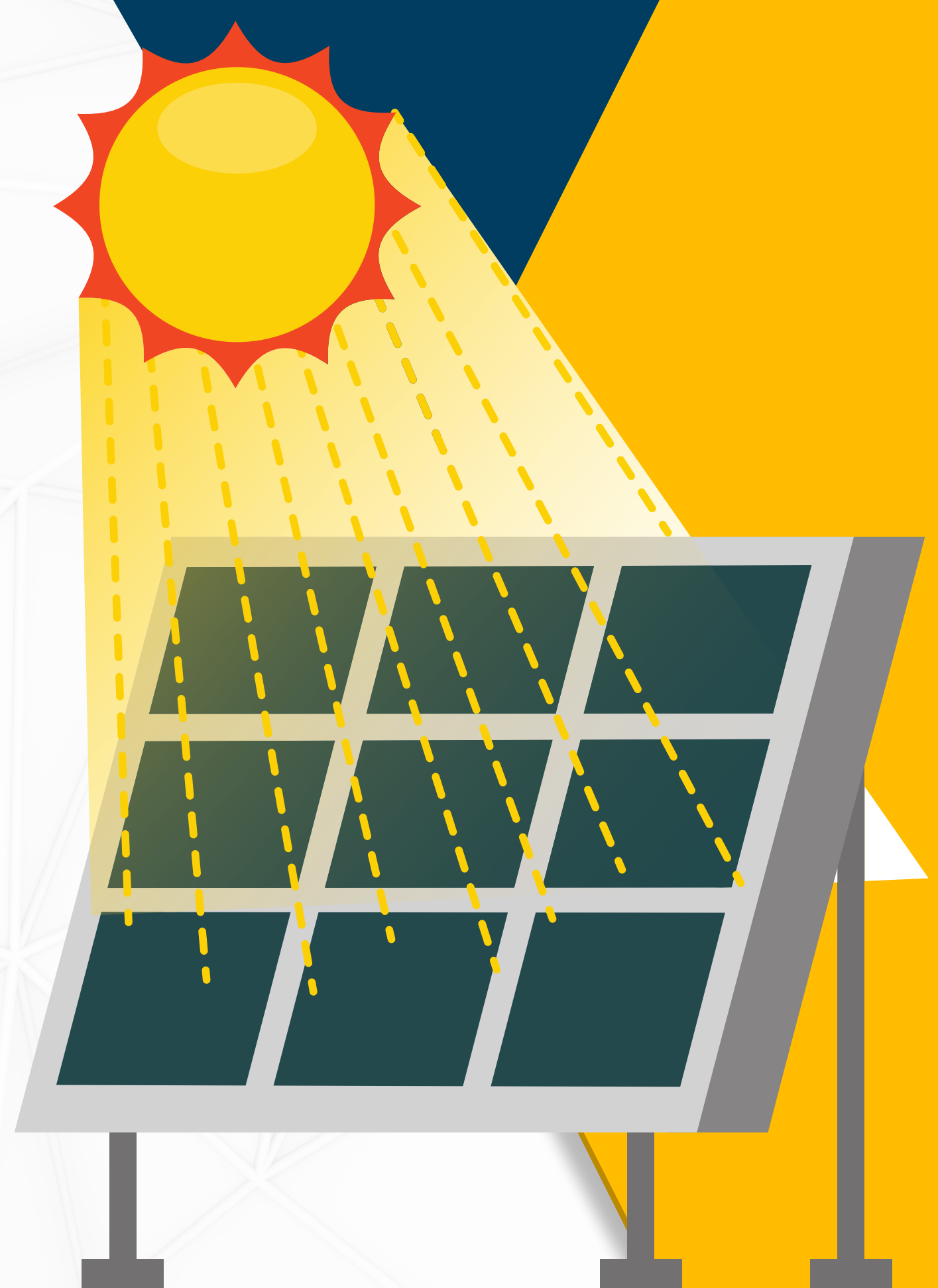
