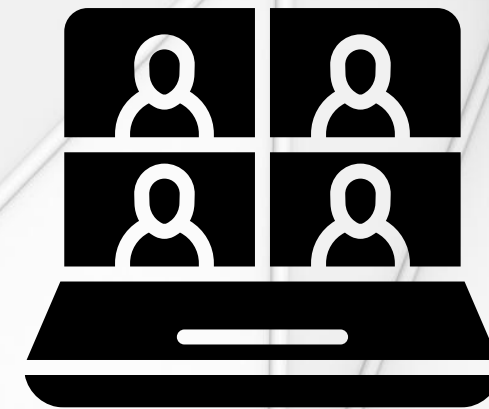

NURSING BOOKS PROJECT

Nursing Books Project was initiated as part of an effort to support Cuttington University in Liberia by providing necessary nursing textbooks and resources. The goal of the project was to help the university meet accreditation requirements set by the government of Liberia. We successfully completed this mission. The project contributed to the university's ability to get accredited, thereby enhancing the quality of nursing education and supporting the development of the healthcare workforce in Liberia.

BUDGET RELIEF AWARD

CUAAA established a Budget Relief Award totaling \$50,000 to assist Cuttington University in overcoming financial challenges by covering some of its critical budgetary expenses. The award was disbursed in three installments: \$20,000, \$15,000, and \$15,000. With the final payment recently made, CUAAA has fully satisfied its commitment to this award, reflecting its dedication to supporting the financial health of their alma mater.



VSAT AWARD \$36,000K

CUAAA also awarded Cuttington University \$36,000 to cover the maintenance costs of the Vsat equipment donated by Alumnus Theo Dennis. The maintenance cost is \$12,000 per year, and CUAAA has consistently fulfilled these payments, ensuring ongoing support for the university's connectivity and communication needs.



CUAAA ROAD PAVING PROJECT

CUAAA has initiated a project to pave the dusty road leading up to Cuttington University's campus. This infrastructure improvement is part of a broader effort to enhance the university's facilities. CUAAA will continue raising funds for this project, demonstrating their ongoing commitment to improving the university's infrastructure and the overall campus environment.



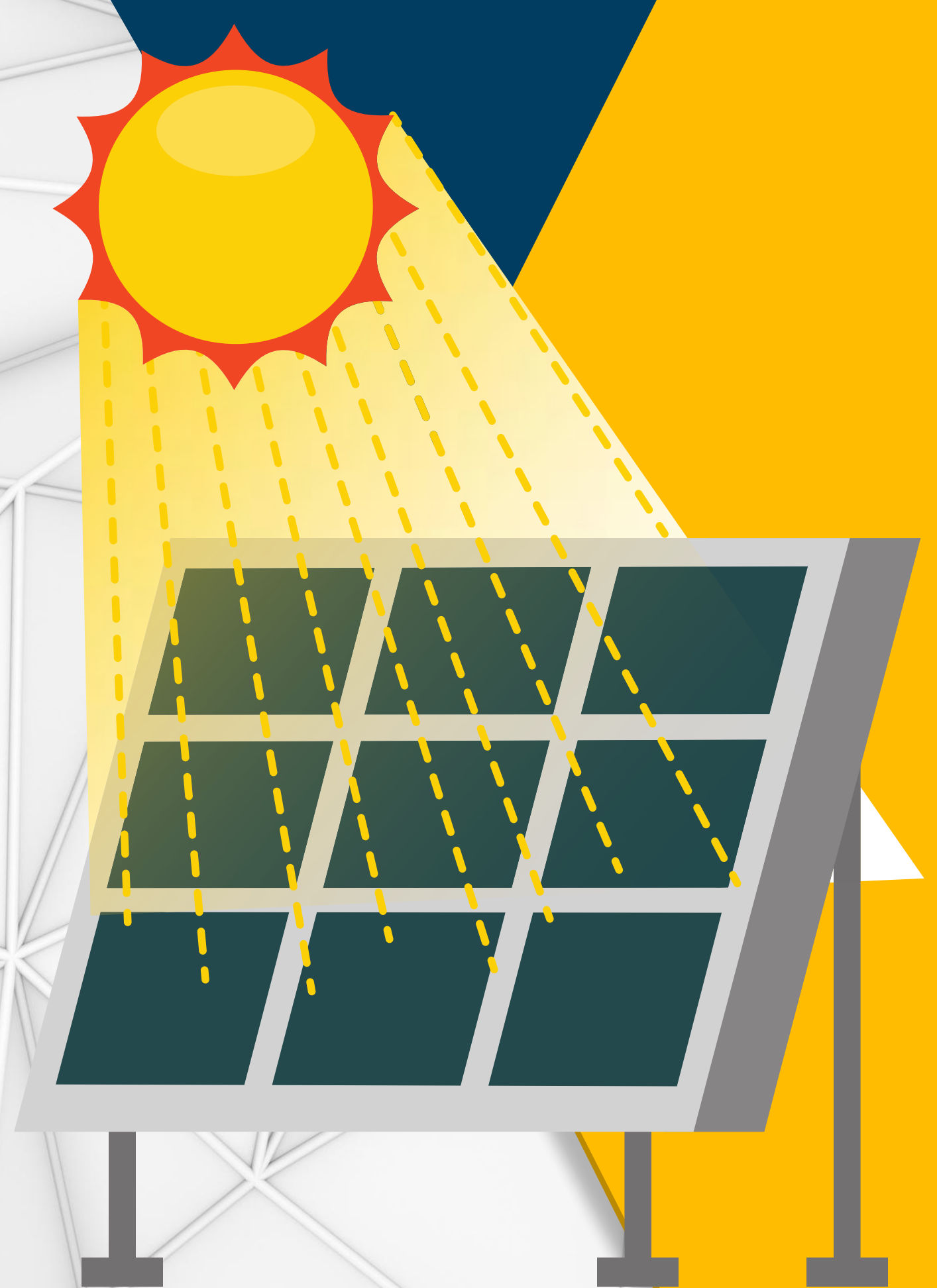
THE NEW AGAPE CLINIC
